RENEW YOUR BODY

January 1, 2023



One Focus: Body

Let us start the year by taking care of our body. The scripture instructs us to present our body as a living sacrifice, holy, and acceptable to God.

Meditation

One Focus: Mind

The simplest way to renew our mind is to focus on a word or creations that reminds us of God. You can repeat quietly “Nothing can separate me from the love of God” or look at the beautiful creation and open your mind to experience the divine presence of God.

Ditch the distraction.

Where is your mind focused on today?

Meditation

“And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.”

Romans 12:2

Prayer & Next Step

- Repeat quietly your favorite Bible verse.
- Don't expect a renewal of your mind overnight.
- Faithfully practice the spiritual discipline of quietly repeating the word of God.
- Follow the pattern of Jesus- Solitude, meditation, prayer, and reading scripture.
- Pray for your family member.
- Read the Renewal devotional daily and keep a journal.



RENEW YOUR SOUL

January 3, 2023



One Focus: Soul

Jesus restores your soul. When you move away from the center (Jesus) you are faced with the great danger of losing your soul. Restoring your soul means coming back to the center.

Ditch worldliness.

What will you profit from gaining the world and losing your soul?

Meditation

“The law of the Lord is perfect, converting the soul (Restoring the Soul); The testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple.” Psalms 19:7

Prayer & Next Step

- Rest your soul in God.
- Feed your soul with honey (Honey in the Rock).
- Read the word of God.
- Wait on the Lord.

RENEW YOUR SPIRIT

January 4, 2023



One Focus: Spirit

Only God can renew a right spirit. David cried out to God to renew a steadfast spirit within him. Renewing our spirit depends on obedience. We can obey when we listen. Without listening to the Holy Spirit, the worldly noise will drown you.

Ditch the noise and be attentive to the movement of the Holy Spirit.

Meditation

And renew a steadfast spirit within me.” Psalm 51:10

The story of Mary and the birth of Jesus reminded us that “With God nothing will be impossible.” Without faith it is impossible to please God. Without faith we cannot renew our faith. Your renewal begins with faith leading to repentance and dependence on God’s grace.

Discard doubt and choose faith.
